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## **WC<sup>2</sup> Partner Commitment Annual Investment Options:**

Four partner levels are available:

### Option 1: Investment

- Remain an active Hydropower Foundation Supporter at the Ambassador's level or above.
- \$5,000 per region with access up to 5 schools

### Option 2: Investment- Expanded

  - c. Provide support during career fairs annually.
  - d. Cover own labor and expenses for all volunteer participation with waterpower clubs, hiring for hydro, and hydro think tanks.
